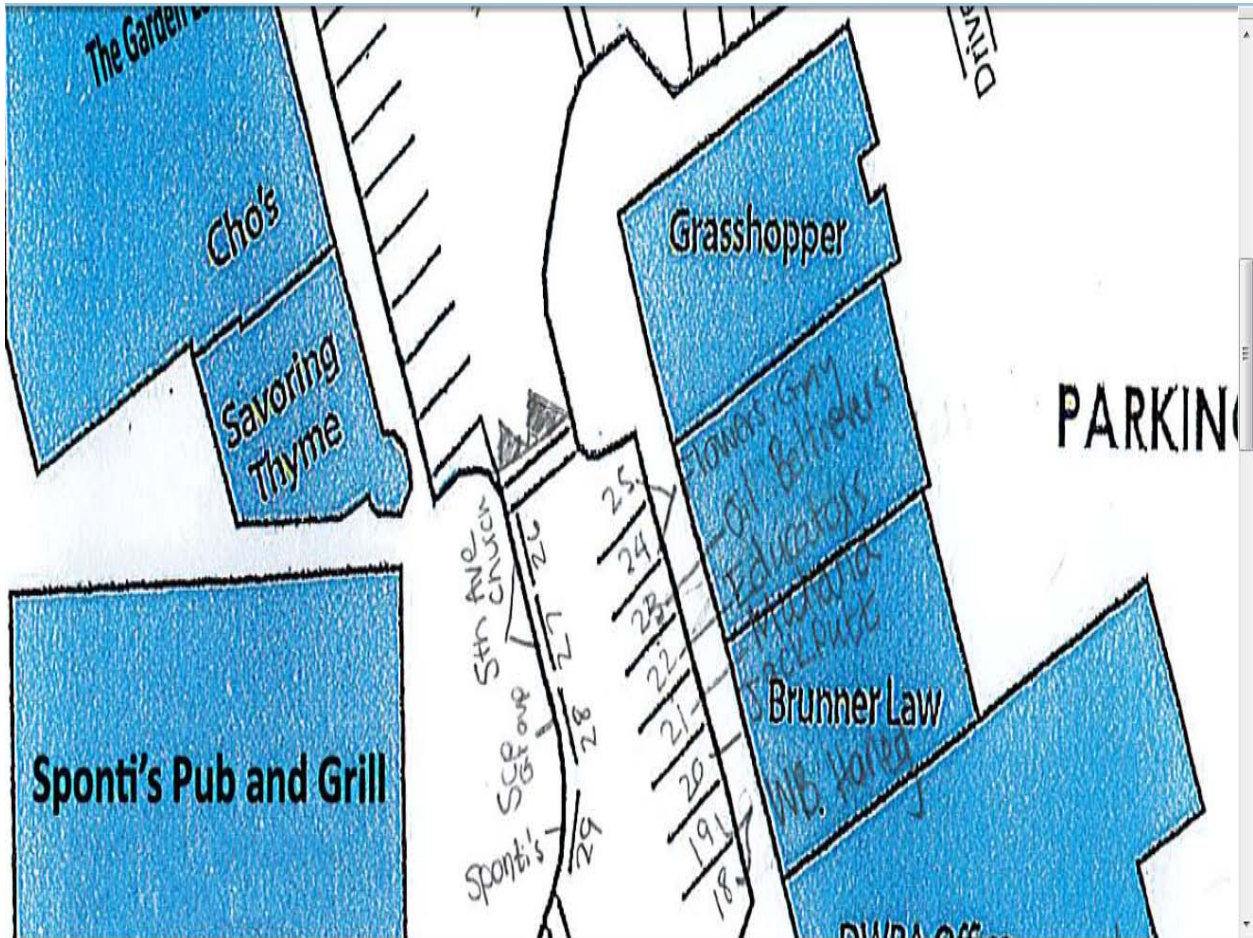


## Maxwell Street Market

Maxwell Street is a street in Chicago that first appears on a map in 1847 according to Wikipedia. The market was established in the 1880s as a means for Jewish peddlers to sell their wares. It existed for almost 100 years until the street was acquired by the university so the market moved from Maxwell Street. The market still takes place to this day every Sunday @ 800 S. Des Plaines St. in Chicago.
