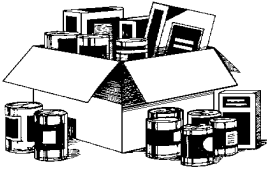

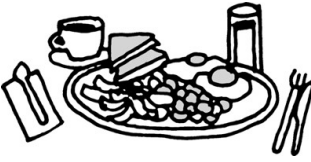


### Lunch Group At the Ridge!
